**1** The sun will rise tomorrow.



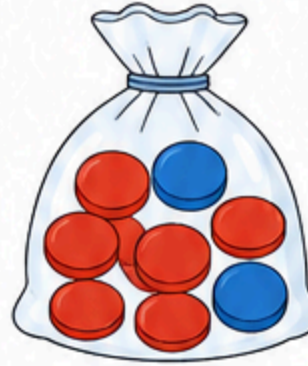

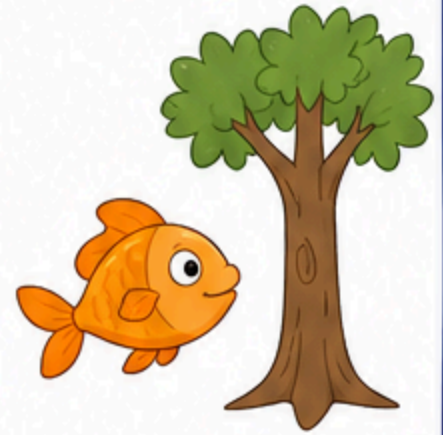

**Tip:**

- Certain** – it will definitely happen. (100% chance)
- Likely** – it will probably happen. (more than 50% chance)
- Possible** – it might happen. (about 50% chance)
- Unlikely** – it probably won't happen. (less than 50% chance)
- Impossible** – it can't happen. (0% chance)
