We can use words like left, right, above, below, in front of and behind.

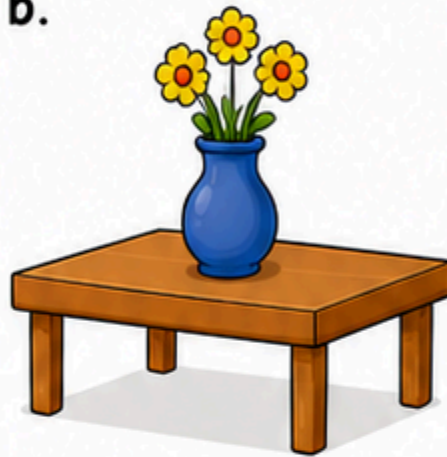

- The fish is below the table.

- The apple is below the books.

- The bottle is in front of the bag.
- The bottle is behind the bag.



Tip: Left and right are from your point of view.
In front of means in front, not to the side.
